#### Application Rate: 20-44 lb Seduce®/A (0.5-1.0 lb/1,000 ft<sup>2</sup>) [0.014-0.031 lb Al Spinosad/A]

Apply Seduce® at planting at labeled rates for control of onion maggots. Apply in 2 x 5" bands across the bedtop. Use the higher rate when pest pressure is high.

### **Crop-Specific Restrictions:**

Do not make more than 5 applications of this product (or any other product containing this ingredient) per calendar year. Do not make more than a total of 0.45 lb Al Spinosad (including foliar and seed uses) per acre per crop.

Do not make applications less than 4 days apart.

Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.
